Product Description

Beagle Plasma (Heparin Sodium Anticoagulant) is prepared by aseptically collecting heparin sodium anticoagulated blood from Beagle dogs and obtaining the supernatant through centrifugation.

Usage

It should be used according to the specific experiment requirements.

Notes

1. Please perform aseptic procedures and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
2. The flocculent precipitate that may appear after plasma freeze-thawing is typically caused by the denaturation of lipoproteins during the freezing and thawing process. It does not affect the quality of the product and can be removed by centrifugation at 3500rpm for 10 minutes.
