

Rat Plasma (Heparin Sodium Anticoagulant)

Product Description

Rat plasma (anticoagulated with sodium heparin) is prepared by aseptically collecting rat blood anticoagulated with sodium heparin, followed by centrifugation to obtain the supernatant.

Usage

It should be used according to the specific experiment requirements.

Notes

1. Please ensure aseptic procedures and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
2. The flocculent precipitate that may appear after plasma freeze-thawing is typically caused by the denaturation of lipoproteins during the freezing and thawing process. It does not affect the quality of the product and can be removed by centrifugation at 3500rpm for 10 minutes.
