Product Overview

IL-27 protein is a member of the IL-6 superfamily, which is expressed on monocytes, endothelial cells and dendritic cells.

It is also referred to as the IL-12 p35-related protein. IL-27 protein is an early product of activated antigen-presenting

cells and drives rapid clonal expansion of naive CD4(+) T cells and plays a role in the early regulation of Th1 cells

initiation which drives efficient adaptive immune response. It has an antiproliferative activity on melanomas through

WSX-1/STAT1 signaling. Thus, IL-27 protein may be an attractive candidate as an antitumor agent applicable to cancer

immunotherapy

Source: Escherichia Coli.

Purity: >95% as determined by SDS-PAGE. Ni-NTA chromatography.

Biological Activity: Measure by its ability to protect HepG2 cells infected with encephalomyocarditis (EMC) virus.

The ED₅₀ for this effect is < 5 ng/mL.

Endotoxin: <0.1 EU per 1 μg of the protein by the LAL method.



Formulation: Lyophilized from a sterile filtered aqueous solution in 1×PBS, pH 4.5.







SDS-PAGE analysis of recombinant mouse IL-27 EBI3

Usage Method

- 1. Before opening, it is recommended to centrifuge at 3000-3500 rpm for 5 minutes.
- 2. Reconstitute to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/mL in sterile distilled H_2O . Allow the solution to sit at room temperature for at least 20 minutes to ensure complete dissolution. Avoid vigorous vortexing.
- 3. The reconstituted solution can be stored at 2-8°C for up to 1 week.
- 4. For long-term storage, it is recommended to further dilute the solution with a carrier protein (such as 0.1% BSA, 10% FBS, or 5% HSA) to a concentration of no less than 10 μ g/mL and aliquot for storage at -20°C to -80°C for 3 to 6 months. If serum-free experiments are required, a 5% trehalose solution can be used as a carrier instead. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
